

## CROSS SECTIONS

NAME	DESCRIPTION
MNR 2	Two-lane minor roadway, undivided with one lane in each direction.
MAU 2	Two-lane major arterial, undivided with one lane in each direction.
MAD 2	Two-lane major arterial, divided with one lane in each direction.
MAU 4	Four-lane major arterial, undivided with two lanes in each direction.
MAD 4	Four-lane major arterial, divided with two lanes in each direction.
MAD 6	Six-lane major arterial, divided with three lanes in each direction.
PKWY 4	Four-lane parkway, divided with two lanes in each direction.
EXPY 6	Six-lane expressway, such as IH-35.
FWY 4	Four-lane freeway, such as the existing 45 SW toll facility.

## GLOSSARY

NAME	DESCRIPTION
MN	Minor roadway (low volume road with a default right-of-way of 60 feet)
MA	Major arterial (thoroughfare that delivers traffic from local roads to freeways, expressways, or other arterials)
D	Divided (roads can be divided by a physical median or a continuous turn lane)
U	Undivided
PKWY	Parkway (generally characterized as scenic routes with large medians)
EXPY	Expressway
FWY	Freeway
